### Training Sessions

The training program consists of three training days. During these days there is an emphasis on giving each student personal attention. In the program students are introduced to International Relations, Politics, Economics and Law. Most of this will be discussed in the framework of the United Nations.

Central to the program is the integration of theory and practice. Public speaking, negotiation and self reflection are core components.

### Model United Nations

The program concludes with a one-day Model United Nations (MUN; a simulation of the United Nations) on the campus of the Radboud University. During the conference, participants take on the role of diplomats, representing countries in the United Nations.

During the MUN, students will have to represent their position, but they will also have to negotiate and cooperate, engaging in dialogue with their peers. This allows them opportunity to test their new skills.

### The Trainers

Quality and accessibility are key words in the program. This is made possible by the trainers because they:

- Have received a half year of training in the substance matter
- Have participated in an award winning academic course that has taken them to Oxford and Harvard Model United Nations.
- Have concluded a preparatory didactics program focussed on
  - › The safe learning environment
  - › Inspiring participants
  - › Conveying knowledge
- Can connect with high school students
- Visibly enjoy MUN themselves.
